Well get your needles ready, Leahe is here to help. She'll walk you through the world of options, including both single color brioche and the more complex two color version. Learn the ins and outs of that mysterious creature, the brioche stitch, without having to deny yourself a single carb.

### Beginning Spinning: Spinning Wheel

Class Dates (two separate sessions offered): **Fri 6/3** 9:30-4:00, **Sat 6/4** 9:30-4:00

**Skill Level:** Beginner

Have you been eyeing the spinning wheels floating around the Sheep? Did you get tempted at Fiber Fest but didn't take the plunge? Here's your chance to get introduced to the wide world of spinning your own yarn on a wheel!

We will teach you about the wheel itself and how to identify its parts, how to treadle with your feet, and adjust tension and ratio. You'll then learn how to spin singles and how to ply singles together to make a sturdier yarn. Then we'll show you to how to wind off your yarn, create a skein, and set the twist so that you can knit it up! Go from total beginner to spinning maniac all in one fun afternoon!

Bring your own spinning wheel if you have one or let us know and we can provide a spinning wheel for you to use during class time, along with all the other necessary fibers and accessories to learn with.

### **Nuno Felting Workshop: Scarves**

Class Dates: **Sat 6/11** 10:00-4:30

**Skill Level:** Beginner

Local Nuno artist Suzanne Morgan will guide you through the beautiful world of Nuno Felting! Create a fabulous wearable composition starting with a piece of hand dyed silk gauze and felting beautiful wools and other textures in an artistic manner to create a scarf you can wear or give as a wonderful gift! Your finished pieces will have fantastic texture. This is a fun and easy class, however, making felt requires that you be able to stand and roll, using your upper body for an hour or more. Instructor will provide composition ideas. Students will need to bring sharp fabric scissors and a towel.

### **Nuno Felting Workshop: Cuffs**

Class Dates: **Sat 6/18** 10:00-2:30

**Skill Level:** Beginner

Create a fabulous wool bracelet starting with fine merino prefelt as your base and adding beautiful hand dyed silks, velvets, yarns, etc as embellishments. We will start by needle felting the silks and other textures in place, then lightly wet felt. Your finished piece will have fantastic texture. The base will be a firm piece of felt that you can further embellish with hand stitching, free motion stitching, or beads. This is a fun and easy class. Instructor will provide composition ideas. Please note: felting requires that students stand and roll with their arms and hands for around 30 minutes. Students will need to bring sharp fabric scissors and a towel.

Cost: \$60 + \$25 project kit (required)



### **Summer Fun with Fiber!**

Looking for something productive for your kids to do this summer? Why not send them to **FIBER CAMP**? This week-long day camp will take your kids through various fiber arts and let them explore the pleasure of working with wool and creating textiles with hands-on workshops. The week will be filled with loads of fiber fun for kids ages 8 and up. Your kiddos will learn all about wool and how to dye it, spin it, weave it and knit it! Ronda and her friends will lead the kids with their enthusiasm and love for all things fibery.

Each day while working in the air conditioned studio we will introduce a new skill for them to practice as



well as inspire and ignite their creativity. They will finish the week with an understanding of how wool goes from the sheep to the finished project while discovering how to combine colors, make a spindle, knit, and make and work on a small weaving loom.

**Quick Start Knit:** (single sessions) **Thurs 5/19** 1:00-2:30, **Wed 5/25** 11:00-12:30, **Tues 5/31** 11:00-12:30

Want to learn the basics? If you have never knit at all, this class is for you. In just 90 minutes you'll learn to cast-on, knit, and bind off – enough skills to make a scarf. You'll need worsted weight yarn and size 8 needles. Supplies are available at the class.

**Quick Start Crochet:** (single sessions) **Wed 5/18** 4:00-5:30, **Friday 5/20** 1:00-2:30, **Tues 5/24** 10:30-12:00, **Thurs 5/26** 5:00-6:30, **Sat 5/28** 2:30-4:00

Want to start hooking? We mean with yarn and a crochet hook of course. You'll learn the basics of single crochet, double crochet and a couple other flips of the wrist that'll get you going. A great way to see if you're interested, or just dusting off your hooks.

**Next Step Knitting:** **Sat 5/21** 11:00-12:30, **Mon 5/23** 3:00-4:30, **Fri 5/27** 1:00-2:30, **Tues 5/31** 2:00-3:30

If you've taken our Quick Start knitting, or have mastered the knit stitch, this is just the class to build on your skills. Learn to purl, combine knit and purl stitches, execute and understand basic increase and decrease techniques, as well as a few bind off methods.

**Seamingly Simple:** **Mon 5/23** 1:00-2:30, **Tues 5/31** 4:00-5:30

Nothing can ruin a beautiful garment like ugly seams. Learn how to neatly weave in ends, and seam together to get confidence in your finishing work. Bring three 4-inch stockinette squares with you to the class (all of the same gauge yarn), leave 2 live on the needle.

### **Knitting Circle**

Dates: **DAILY!**

**M/W/F** 3:00-5:00 and **T/Th** 1:00-3:00

We're so excited to have expanded into the shop next door and now we're taking full advantage of it! You've asked us for more opportunities to learn tips and techniques and this is the place to do it!

Five days a week (Monday through Friday), we host **Knitting Circles** - the opportunity to get help with everything from dropped stitches to tricky patterns, or whatever knitting and crochet confusion you might have. Every day there is a 2 hour period dedicated to helping our customers with questions, pattern interpretation, and more. During each session, there will be a knitting "coach" on hand to provide this help and support!
